The annual conference held in October covers a broad range of subjects, including genetics of cardiovascular diseases, vascular biology, cardiac and renal aspects as well as modern strategies of prevention and therapy in cardiovascular disease.

This highly dynamic field is characterized by the rapid accumulation of new information that contributes to our understanding of the aetiology and pathophysiology of cardiovascular disease processes as well as to the development of better therapeutic strategies. Particular emphasis is put on the participation of both basic scientists and clinicians to foster the transmission of new scientific findings into clinical practice. Besides including invited keynote lectures, free oral presentations, workshops and hot topic sessions, the programme provides ample time for discussion both within and outside the scientific sessions.
